Lesson's aim: The student will be able to describe a picture and reflect on their mistakes.

They have fear of something down.	The cats are scared afraid frightened of the man. the dog. the noise.

The man has no emotion.	The man does not react. The man doesn't show any emotion.
He sits against the wall.	He leans on/against the wall. ex: to lean on / against something - He leaned his head on her shoulder.

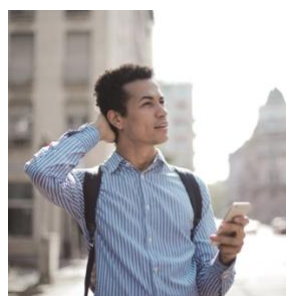
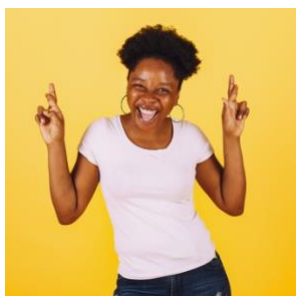
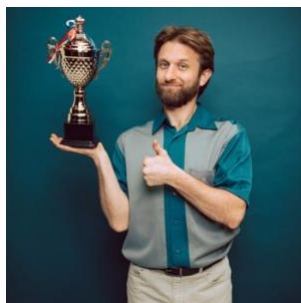
